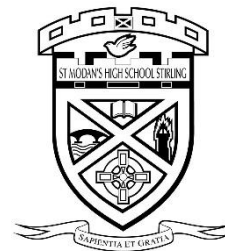

Mathematics Easter Support Programme



Dear Parent/Carer,

In an extra effort to help our young people achieve their potential in their final Mathematics Examinations in May, we are running a 2-day Easter Support Programme on Monday 11th April and Tuesday 12th April 2016.

All pupils in S4-S6 that will be sitting a final examination at National 5 or Higher Level are being catered for and supported by staff from the Mathematics department on both days; with provision to meet the needs of all pupils in the run up to the examinations. The format of each day is 100% directed at exam attainment, with revision of specific styles of questions and exam technique being covered. This is in addition to the Supported Study timetable that we have had in place since September.

We would hope to have a significant turnout of pupils for these days, and ask you to encourage your son/daughter to attend; this is an excellent opportunity for them to be supported in their studies over the Easter break.
