

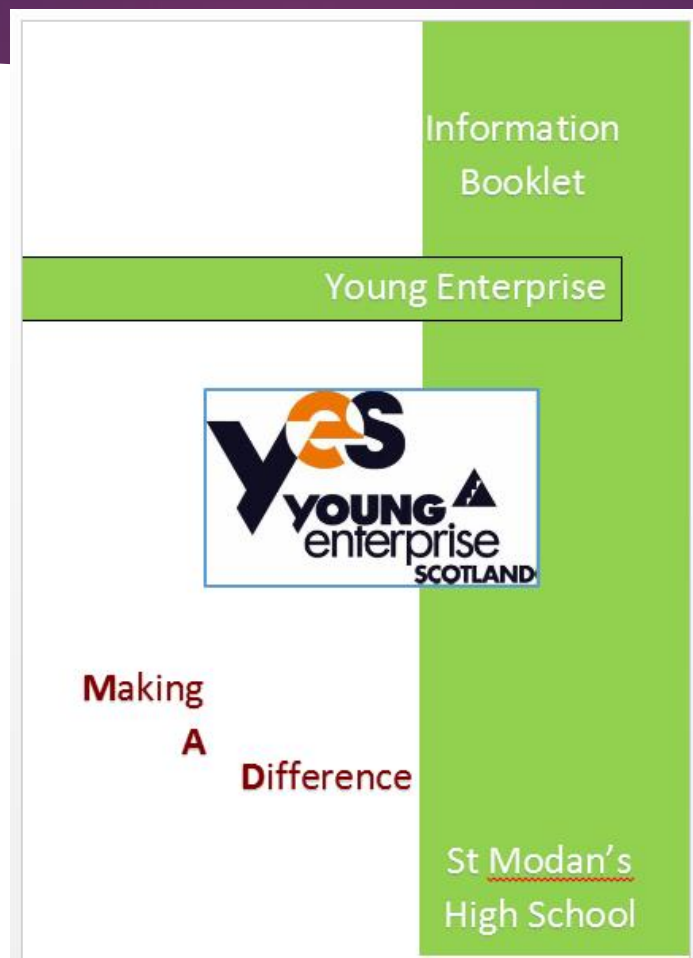

- ▶ S5/6 opportunities

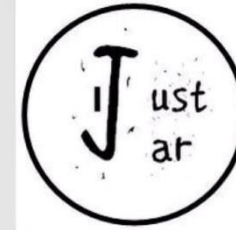


Young Enterprise S6 ONLY



- ▶ **What is Young Enterprise?**
- ▶ The Young Enterprise Company Programme which has been running nationally since 1963 and in that time over a million 15-19 year olds have taken part.
- ▶ The Company gives young people the opportunity to set up and run a real business under the guidance of a **Business Volunteer**.
- ▶ The Company runs throughout one academic year, and teams can be made up of between **6** and **25** students.
- ▶ Teams compete between **Forth Valley** and on a **National level** too and there are even opportunities to gain additional qualifications.

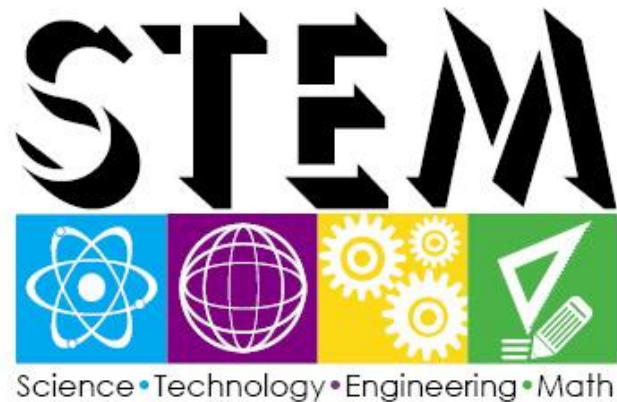

Employer Engagement

- ▶ Currently working with a number of employers and organisations to deliver workshops on CV writing, Interviews as well as worked linked learning within subjects.



Ways to help

- ▶ Involvement in Careers events.
- ▶ Offering Work experience placements (various timescales e.g. a week, a day per week...)
- ▶ Assistance within individual subject areas.
- ▶ One – to – one mentoring e.g. CV writing, UCAS applications, mock interviews.
- ▶ Delivery of Assemblies/class talks.
- ▶ Leading Career workshops - Practical advice to our pupils on the skills connected with specific jobs
