

ST MODAN'S HIGH SCHOOL

An outbreak of diarrhoea and vomiting has been reported at St Modan's High School in Stirling. Deep cleaning is being carried out daily in all areas of the school, which remains open.

Samples are still being tested but symptoms correlate with those of norovirus. Please find enclosed a leaflet detailing the signs and symptoms of the virus and how to prevent its spread.

It is important to note:

- Pupils who feel unwell in any way should stay away from school
- Anyone who has been ill must not return to school until 48 hours **after** their last symptoms
- To stop the spread of the virus you must wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water particularly after going to the toilet and before eating
- Keep all surfaces clean, for example desks and computing equipment.
